CERTIFICATIONS :

CYA Basic Cruising Skills (Canadian Yachting Association):

You need to be registered in our *Summer of Sailing in Aylmer Program* to be able to participate in this training program. The program will provide you with the skills necessary to challenge the CYA Basic Cruising exam through structured theoretical and on-water sessions. The CYA objectives for this skill level are to develop the competency necessary for safe sailing in day outings under moderate conditions and in known waters. Additional fees are required to cover the cost of materials and CYA examination and certification. Fees vary on a case-by-case basis; please check with the Training Coordinator.

Pleasure Craft Operator Card (PCOC):

To reduce the number of boating accidents, Transport Canada has introduced new boating regulations that require every motor craft operator to successfully pass an approved boating safety test. Members of the GBSC may challenge the written test to obtain their PCOC. Additional nominal fees are required to cover the cost of materials and certification; please check with the Training Coordinator.

GBSC Refund Policy:

For Live-aboard cruising programs (e.g. Georgian Bay, Lake Champlain...) or the combined programs, the GBSC and the member have the following mutual obligations:

- 1) The GBSC will reimburse the member for the portion corresponding to the program if the program cannot be offered.
- 2) When a member is unable to participate in the program for which he/she has registered, the member who is withdrawing undertakes to find a replacement. The replacement will pay the same rate paid by the member withdrawing (including rebates). However, the replacement must fulfil all the requirements for membership in the GBSC. The GBSC will then reimburse the member withdrawing for the fee, or the portion of the fee for the program in question, less \$25.
- 3) In the situation where it is the GBSC that finds a replacement for the member withdrawing, the fee required of the replacement will be the fee applicable at the time of registration of the replacement. The GBSC will reimburse the member withdrawing the program fee, or the portion of the fee applicable to the program in question, less \$25.
- 4) In the event where no replacement can be found, no reimbursement will be made to the member who has withdrawn.

In relation to the above policy, each case must be presented to the Board of Directors for approval. The GBSC will enforce this policy rigorously.

WAIVER: PLEASE READ AND SIGN

CANCELLATIONS AND REFUNDS: *The GBSC is not responsible for outings or training cancelled due to weather, required repairs or unavailability of skippers. Accordingly, there will be no refunds, transfers or credits to members or guests for cancelled outings or training.*
